A WORD FROM FATHER KELLY

Well, it is now official: as of the 1st of July 2013 I will become pastor of St. James Church in McMinnville (about 50 minutes SW of Portland). It is a parish about half the size of Sacred Heart, but still has a school and two other parishes attached to it. Certainly some new challenges await me there. As well, Father Ben Tapia-Ortiz will also be moved on the 1st of July. He will continue as Parochial Vicar but at St. Alexander's, Cornelius, and St. Edward's, North Plains. He will be working with Father David Schiferl.

I had already shared with you a couple of weeks ago that the new Pastor of Sacred Heart Church and St. Joseph Mission will be Father Ken Sampson. Now with the departure of Father Ben, you will also be receiving a new Parochial Vicar: Father Arturo Romero. Father Arturo is coming from St. Luke's Church in Woodburn. Both are very fine men and I know you will find them to be excellent pastors as together you continue on this journey of faith.

Our lives are not the only ones changing. On Thursday evening we will gather for the graduation of our Sacred Heart Catholic School eighth-grade class with the celebration of the Eucharist and the granting of Eighth-grade Diplomas. As these students now turn their focus toward high school, they will face new challenges and opportunities that will continue to shape the course of their young lives and the ability to bring the faith they have learned throughout these years into a new environment; they will become evangelizers of faith in a new way!

On Wednesday evening the St. Mary School community will gather for the Baccalaureate Mass celebrated here at Sacred Heart Church. Already these young men and women have given thought, reflection, and discernment as to where God is calling them next. Some will go on to the college and university setting while others will enter the nation's work force. Whatever their next move, they too, will be called upon to testify to what they have learned of their faith and become true witnesses and proclaimers of the Gospel message. Congratulations to all of our graduates!

**MISSIONARY COOPERATIVE
PLAN APPEAL**

St. Patrick's Missionary Society, (also known as St. Patrick Fathers) was formally established on March 17, 1932. The Society was founded by Irish Diocesan priests who initially had gone to work on a temporary basis in Nigeria, West Africa, but who later wished to dedicate their lives fully to the Missions. Later as the new missionary society grew, more work was undertaken, not only in Nigeria but also in Kenya (1951), Brazil (1962), Malawi (1970), Grenada (1970), Zambia (1973), Sudan (1983), Zimbabwe (1989), Cameroon (1989) and Homelands of South Africa (1989). In the United States the Society has one house in Chicago. Their address is:
8422 W. Windsor Ave. Chicago, IL 60656-1452.

A few society priests work in dioceses in the United States. There are now 300 priests in the society, of which 21 are newly ordained African priests. After a drop in vocations in recent years, there are now more than 64 preparing for the priesthood in information centers in Nigeria, Kenya and South Africa. Most of the people among who we work are extremely poor, and we have no means of training our seminarians and supporting our priests in their work other than the donations we receive. Father Michael Madigan of the St. Patrick Fathers, will be the celebrant at all English Masses next weekend. A second collection will be taken up at that time for the mission work of St. Patrick Fathers.
