**FATHER KEN'S KORNER**

Hopefully my "Because You Asked" series will resume in the Fall as we gather questions from parishioners on scripture, the liturgy, our catechism or other topics. In the mean time, through the summer, I give you Part 4 of Pastor's Notes where I cover parish news you need to know:

Short-Term Projects for our Parish Campus

Last week I let you know that slowly but surely we are putting together a 25 year facilities plan for our parish campus. This has included both an architectural check-up for our church building complete with cost estimates and a timeline for regular repairs and a 25 year assessment of the rest of the campus, including our school. Even as we strive to complete that though we are already focusing on some regular summer maintenance projects which we annually take on. Usually these involve energy and safety grants also so that we can get more "bang for the buck". In the past, since I have been here, these have included; repaving the walks around our Jacksonville mission so that they are more level, adding security cameras, upgrading lighting in the parish hall, church and parking lot, replacing the church and hall sound systems, reroofing the parish hall and upgrading the electrical capacity of the church and the fire safety system, among others. In the upcoming months we will be working on the following:

1. We will do an upgrade on the exterior church lighting to reduce the amount of dark areas at night. This will make it safer for parishioners to come to evening events and we hope it will deter crime as well by removing hiding spaces.

2. In late July we will remodel our parish hall kitchen. This is one of our most often used spaces and we have raised the money for this upgrade and had the equipment already ordered on standby. The reason for the delay in this project has been finding a time when the kitchen is not reserved for major parish events. During the last half of July, the kitchen floor will be replaced and other wall issue will be looked at. Then all new appliances will be brought in. These will be both more energy efficient and larger in order to accommodate higher volume use. I understand that the old equipment will be donated to a Boy Scout Summer Camp.

3. The church choir loft railing will be raised in height for safety. We have also tried to choose a design that will honor the historic look of the church but the current rail is too low for current safety standards so we are looking forward to correcting this.

4. Down the road we plan to do a minor remodeling of our church sacristy with new cabinets, painting and wall repair.

5. We had set up a multi-year plan to gradually replace all of our HVAC units (that operate heating and cooling) mounted on the parish hall roof with one being replaced per year. However, they are failing at a faster rate than originally projected so we have decided to replace them all in one shot.

Our only proposed repair that was declined by the archdiocese was our proposal to reroof the Jacksonville mission using more modern roofing material that is more fire resistant. Our safety grant team did not feel this change would provide sufficient safety benefits for the cost. I will keep you all updated on further projects as they unfold.
