FATHER KEN'S CORNER

Catholic Schools Week

This weekend marks the end of Catholic Schools Week as both Sacred Heart School and St. Mary's School continue to celebrate 151 years of Catholic education in the Rogue Valley. I thought it might be useful this week to post some of the information on Catholic Schools Week from the National Catholic Educational Association (NCEA) as we close out this week of celebration of our school staff, benefactors, and student body along with their families:

"What is National Catholic Schools Week?"

Since 1974, National Catholic Schools Week is the annual celebration of Catholic education in the United States. It starts the last Sunday in January and runs all week, which in 2017 is January 29 - February 4. The theme for the National Catholic Schools Week 2017 is "Catholic Schools: Communities of Faith, Knowledge and Service." Schools typically observe the annual celebration week with Masses, open houses and other activities for students, families, parishioners and community members. Through these events, schools focus on the value Catholic education provides to young people and its contributions to our church, our communities and our nation...The theme encompasses several concepts that are at the heart of a Catholic education. First, schools are communities—small families in their own right, but also members of the larger community of home, church, city and nation. Faith, knowledge and service are three measures by which any Catholic school can and should be judged."

These are values we have tried to instill here locally, first of all with greater focus on Sacred Heart School as being an integral part of the parish as its' number

one ministry. With regular school Mass, service outreach to our local community and clergy class visits along with regular faith formation activities we have tried to make sure that the Catholic identity of the school remains strong. We have also tried to honor and pass on the Catholic legacy formed over the previous 150 years here in the Rogue Valley.

This year Sacred Heart School has set out to celebrate Catholic Schools Week in the following way:

Last Weekend – Mass announcements about the week and the value of Catholic education

Monday – "Sunday Best Dressed Day" with school Mass and student prayer chain.

Tuesday – "Comfy Casual Day" with letter writing to priests, parish staff and the homebound and student prayer chain. Evening Parent Night in the parish hall with a State of the School Address by principal Leslie Jones.

Wednesday – "Crazy Hat and Socks Day" with an All School Prayer Service and pledge salute as well as student prayer chain

Thursday – "Decade Day" with student prayer chain and K-8 bowling field trip.

Friday – In Service Teacher Day.

Along with maintaining the spiritual identity of our school we are also excited to look forward to future playground upgrades, an early child care program to be added, upgrades to the facilities with summer work being done on the entryway and reception area of the school as well as painting of the facilities and several new curricular innovations. If you are curious, come check us out and arrange a tour of our school. We are very proud of who we are and only aim to get better!



BATTLE OF THE BOOKS

Oregon Battle of the Books (OBOB) is a statewide voluntary reading motivation and comprehension program sponsored by the Oregon Association of School Libraries in conjunction with a Library Services and Technology Act grant. Students in 3rd-12th grade, regardless of ability, are exposed to quality literature representing a variety of literary styles and viewpoints.

OBOB's mission is to encourage and recognize students who enjoy reading, to broaden reading interests, to increase reading comprehension, promote academic excellence, and to promote cooperative learning and teamwork among students.

OBOB is run completely by volunteers through the Oregon Association of School Libraries (OASL) and funded partially through the Library Services and Technology Act, LSTA.

The battles for the Sacred Heart students have begun. We have 8 teams of 3rd-5th graders competing. The students have read 16 books since summertime. The top teams will be competing on March 10 at Abraham Lincoln School. Go Sacred Heart!
