FATHER KEN'S CORNER

Fatima Event Timeline

As I mentioned in last week's bulletin, in honor of the Fatima 100th anniversary, I am providing you all, in summary form, a timeline of events that were reported to have occurred in Fatima, Portugal a century ago. This should provide the basics for those not familiar with Our Lady of Fatima. For greater detail, visit EWTN.com with the key words "Fatima 100th Anniversary". Now check out the timeline:

1916 – On three separate occasions, three Portuguese children, Lucia Santos (9 yrs.) and her cousins Francisco (8 yrs.) and Jacinta (6 yrs.) Marto, are visited by an angel as they herd sheep in the hills. He instructs them how to pray and make sacrifice in reparation for the sin of the world. He identifies himself as the Angel of Peace and the Angel of Portugal. During his final appearance he carries with him the Eucharist. For a time, he leaves the Eucharist levitating in the air unsupported and the angel and children bow down before it and adore it. Then the angel gives the host to Lucia to consume and offers the chalice to Francisco and Jacinta. This experience serves as spiritual preparation for further apparitions to come in the following year. (It should be noted that throughout the six months of Marian apparitions that would later occur, Mary never identifies herself by name until the final apparition in October. Also, for whatever reason, in all of those later apparitions the children experience, only Lucia and Jacinta could both see and hear her speak. Francisco could only see her and had to rely on the two girls to share with him the contents of her messages).

1917 (May 13th) – Mary appears for the first time to the children. She asks that they pray the Rosary daily for world peace (as World War I is currently being fought in Europe) and to return to the same place (a field called Cova da Iria just outside the town of Fatima) for the next five months on the 13th of each month. She prays the Rosary with them. Afterward, Jacinta in her excitement is unable to keep the events secret and tells her mother. As a result, Lucia especially and the other children are punished and persecuted for "making up lies". Lucia is forced to speak to the local pastor about the seriousness of blasphemy but she refuses to deny the story no matter what is threatened.

1917 (June 13th) – On the feast of St. Anthony of Lisbon, the most important saint of Portugal, the children reject going to the "Children's Feast" held in town in favor of following Mary's instructions to return to the apparition site which their parents find odd and uncharacteristic. During this apparition, among other things, Mary informs the children that Francisco and Jacinta will be with her in Heaven soon but that Lucia will have to remain behind for a time. (This refers to the childhood deaths of the two youngest during the flu epidemic of 1919 while Lucia would eventually die at 97 yrs. old in 2005). About 50 curious villagers are on hand and though they cannot see or hear Mary, many report being able to see a floating cloud or glowing lightning in the place where she appears. The children are later troubled when the local priest

advised them that these visions may be from the devil. Still they refuse to renounce them.

1917 (July 13th) – On this day, Lucia considers not going because of the words of her pastor but when the day finally arrives a new peace comes over her. There are now about 5000 onlookers at hand due to word of mouth for this third Marian apparition as the children return to the site. Mary shares a Great Secret in three parts with the children that will not be revealed until 1941 by Lucia under holy obedience to her bishop. They are also told that the sufferings of World War I can be brought to a sooner end through devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and through prayer and sacrifice for the conversion of the world. If change does not come, Mary predicts that a greater war (World War II) will soon follow during the reign of Pope Pius XI (not yet a pope). This 2nd war will bring even greater loss of life and this war will also be preceded by a sign in the sky (Lucia later confirms the rare occurrence of Aurora Borealis seen throughout Europe a month prior to the war breaking out as that sign). The prediction comes to pass as described but these things are not part of the so-called 3-part secret, according to Lucia. The first part of the secret later revealed in 1941 involves the children being shown a vision of Hell with damned souls falling into it like snowflakes and Mary urging the children to pray for God's mercy on sinners. They are told that it is important for them to understand that Hell is real and the urgent need to pray for the conversion of the world is also real. (This experience more than any other changed these children profoundly forever after. Francisco, who was quiet by nature, began to lose all interest in school. He regularly skipped school in order to spend the entire day in prayer. When asked what he wanted to be when he grew up he is known to have said that he did not want to be anything. He wanted to die and go to Heaven. Jacinta was formerly bubbly and social by nature but afterward became very serious and went to the greatest extremes in her attempts to sacrifice things for sinners even desiring to die alone after much suffering, which she later did. And Lucia later shared that if they had not all been promised beforehand that they would all go to Heaven they would have died of fright at seeing the vision of Hell. In old black-and-white photos of the children you can see this seriousness carved into their expressions). The 2nd part of the secret involves Russia (an insignificant country at that time) and the threat it will later pose to the world if it is not consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the world does not pray for its conversion. Left unchecked and without such prayer they are told that Russia will replicate its errors throughout the world. (This is later revealed as the expansion of atheistic communism and the Cold War. It is not until Pope John Paul II that this consecration of Russia is completed as requested but much avoidable damage and violence occurs in the world as a result of the delay). The 3rd part is controversial because it is passed from the local bishop to the pope directly (unread) and is passed on from pope to pope, unrevealed to the world until modern times.

FATHER KEN'S CORNER

It involves an apocalyptic image of the Church with a hill of martyrs and a pope dressed in white struck down. (After the later failed assassination attempt on Pope John Paul II, while he is recovering, the pope requests the official copy of the Fatima secrets which he reads. He later concludes that the pope in the vision is himself and that the composite images are a warning like the other two parts of the secret rather than being unavoidable fates. Pope John Paul II becomes convinced that Our Lady of Fatima has saved his life as a result of the prayers and sacrifice made by the faithful through the Fatima message. As he later puts it, "One hand fired the gun and another hand guided the bullet." When he recovers enough to travel he makes a pilgrimage to Fatima and places the bullet recovered from his body in the crown of Our Lady's statue in Fatima). In the final part of the apparition, Lucia attempts for the 1st time to get Mary to reveal her identity and to perform a miracle so that the crowds will believe that the children are telling the truth. She refuses but promises to reveal her name and perform a great miracle in her final appearance in October.

1917 (August 13th – 19th) – Prior to the scheduled apparition in August, town mayor Artur Santos kidnaps the children and takes them to the local jail where he threatens to torture them and take them away from their parents forever if they do not change their story. He also threatens to boil them alive in hot oil and other such things if they do not reveal the secrets to him. Santos is a fallen away Catholic and high mason and is determined to bring these local events to an end no matter the cost and even locks them up with adult criminals but, regardless of what he threatens, the children refuse. Santos decides he will continue to hold them against their will and cause them to miss their scheduled apparition on the 13th by keeping them until the 15th. Crowds gather at the site anyway and people in the crowd report once again seeing clouds and strange light as before even though the children are missing (i.e. Mary kept her promise and showed up). Finally Santos releases them on August 15th (The Feast of the Assumption) and the town's people learn what their mayor has tried to do and why the children were absent. Mary appears to the children on the 19th and tells them to continue to try to keep the schedule of the 13th of each month. She asks that for September they use some alms given through the months to hold a special procession and to begin work on a future chapel to be built on the apparition spot.

1917 (September 13th) – Mary again tells them of a great miracle that will be worked during her final apparition in October and she prays with them and urges them to come back the next month. At last she rises up into the sky and the children urge the crowds to look up if they wish to see her. Some later claim that they were able to see her.

1917 (October 13th) – After two days of ongoing heavy rain more than 70,000 gather in the field. The crowds churn the field to mud and are soaked by the foul weather but they persist in remaining because of the promised miracle that they will reportedly be able to see. When Mary appears and is once again asked her name by Lucia she responds by saying that she is "Our Lady of the Rosary". She reaffirms to the children that she wants a chapel built on this spot and that she wants the faithful to continue saying the Rosary daily and making sacrifices. Shortly after that the promised miracle takes place, later known as "The Miracle of the Sun". The sun changed in appearance so that all present can directly look at it without harming their eyes. It then begins to dance around the sky and at one point it seemed to race toward the earth, growing rapidly in size. The crowd screams in terror thinking that the sun will crash into the earth. After about ten minutes of this the sun ceases dancing and the people come to realize that their clothing and the field with all its mud is entirely dry. Then a series of giant images stretched across the sky appear for all to see including ones of Jesus, Our Lady of Sorrows, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel and St. Joseph holding the child Jesus and blessing the gathered crowd. These things are witnessed by Christians of various faiths, by those of other faith traditions and even by atheists. In the crowd are reputable journalists and scientists as well who report the events to the world. Still today, this event is considered to be the most widely witnessed paranormal or supernatural event ever in human history.

Note: After the deaths of Francisco and Jacinta Marto, when Lucia reaches adulthood and enters religious life as a Carmelite nun, she reports that on special occasions Mary continues to appear to her to advise her about the secrets and other things. Francisco and Jacinta were beatified together on May 13th 2000 on the apparition anniversary by St. Pope John Paul II. Their bodies were transferred to the Fatima shrine for burial and this shrine continues today to be one of the most popular Christian pilgrimage sites in the world. These two children will be officially canonized as saints on May 13th 2017 (again on the anniversary) by Pope Francis. Currently Lucia (deceased in 2005) has been declared a Servant of God which means that her canonization process has officially been opened.

What a Great Night!

On Thursday, May 4, Sacred Heart School held their annual **ACADEMIC SHOWCASE AND OPEN HOUSE!**

All the grades displayed different classroom activities and it was a chance for the students to share with their parents what they have been working on in their classrooms.

Some of the highlights of the evening were the different science experiments that took place in the gym. They had chemical reactions with balloons, series circuits where the kids were able to light a lightbulb, experiments with solid liquid gas using a film canister with alka seltzer and water and watch the canister pop up into the air.

Another science favorite was the **squid dissection in the STEM room. 20 lucky students and their parents** were able to dissect a squid under the able tutelage of Mrs. Suzie Schweitzer. They even were able to write their names with ink from the squids. The second grade divided up their room into different biomes. There was a desert biome, a forest biome, an aquatic biome, etc. They also shared their animal reports with their parents.

It was exhilarating to watch the pride that the students displayed in sharing their projects with their parents. The older students each did a short oral presentation which was well received. The interaction between parents and kids was priceless.

It was exciting to see the smiles and hear the laughter in the halls during this event.
